Panic button

One press of the panic button triggers a panic alarm that immediately warns all your registered contacts. Hold the button for a few seconds to trigger the alarm. The Egardia panic button is always operative regardless of your alarm system being turned on or off. The waterproof panic button can be worn around the neck thanks to the supplied neck cord.

Please note! In the event of a burglar alarm or a panic alarm the gateway will emit a constant and loud sound. A panic alarm can only be turned off with a key pad. Enter a valid PIN code and press the green lock icon button to turn the panic alarm off.

INSTALLING THE PANIC BUTTON

The installation process of the Egardia panic button consists of three easy steps.

STEP 1.	CHECK CONTENTS	CHECK THE CONTENTS OF THE BOX
STEP 2.	ADD TO ALARM SYSTEM	REGISTER THE PANIC BUTTON WITH YOUR EGARDIA ALARM SYSTEM
STEP 3.	CHECK AND TEST	CHECK AND TEST THE PANIC BUTTON

STEP 1: CHECK CONTENTS

Check the contents of the packaging for the following parts:

- 1. Panic button (battery is factory installed in the panic button)
- 2. Neck cord

STEP 2: ADD TO ALARM SYSTEM

You are now about to register the panic button with your Egardia alarm system.

- 1. Ensure at your gateway that the alarm is turned off. The top indicator light (Status) and the bottom indicator light (Online) are lit green.
- Press the "Reset" button at the side of the gateway for at least 5 seconds. The top indicator light (Status) of your gateway flashes green to indicate it is searching for new accessories.
- Press the panic button. The gateway beeps once to indicate the panic button is successfully registered. The gateway beeps twice to indicate the panic button has already been successfully registered.
- 4. Press again the "Reset" button at the side of the gateway for at least 5 seconds if no more accessories are being added. The gateway returns to normal operation.
- 5. Login to your Egardia account and go to the tab "Alarm system". The registered panic button will appear after a few minutes.
- 6. Rename the panic button for easy recognition.

STEP 4: CHECK AND TEST

To make sure that the panic button functions correctly it is advisable to test the panic button.

Press the panic button for a few seconds to trigger a panic alarm. If the alarm is triggered and all your registered contacts receive an alarm message the panic button has been installed correctly.

Congratulations! The installation is complete.

MAINTENANCE

Battery

The panic button is powered by one CR2025 3V lithium button cell battery. Depending on use, the average life of the battery is 10. To prevent damage to the panic button, it is not possible to replace the battery. When the battery is low the panic button should be replaced by a new panic button.
